Car Parking: Please do not obstruct the public footpath when parking your car at the Church. This inconveniences pedestrians who have to step into the road to get past, and is dangerous.

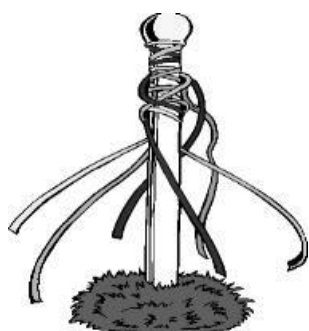
