Our tenth family is about to arrive: a couple and their eight-year-old son. They are Christians who have fled persecution in Iran. We are looking to rent a house or flat for them with at least one bedroom, ideally at no more than £800 per month. Does anyone have such a property to let or know someone who does? Failing that, would anyone be willing to accept the little family as house guests on a short-term basis until we can move them into a suitable property?
