London Run to the Cardinal Hume Centre

This takes place this coming Wednesday 21 June. Please bring your contributions to church as usual, and leave them in the Presbytery porch or Presbytery itself, by 12 noon on that day. We need non-perishable food items - e.g. tinned veg, tinned soup, tinned fish, tinned meat (but not spam please!), cereal bars, dried pasta, rice, coffee, tea bags, etc., and household items such as detergent, washing up liquid, cleaning fluids etc. Also welcomed are toiletries, nappies and women's sanitary products. We would be most grateful if you can make sure all food items are still within their "use by" date. The Cardinal Hume Centre really appreciate our continued support for their young and vulnerable clients. So thank you.

Wycombe Refugee Partnership helps destitute refugee families with legal status to resettle and build a new life in High Wycombe. Our tenth family is about to arrive: a couple and their eight-year-old son. They are Christians who have fled persecution in Iran. We are looking to rent a house or flat for them with at least one bedroom, ideally at no more than £800 per month. Does anyone have such a property to let or know someone who does? Failing that, would anyone be willing to accept the little family as house guests on a short-term basis until we can move them into a suitable property?
