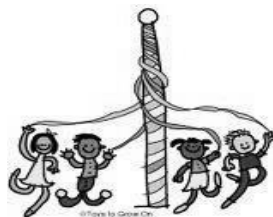
Every Thursday: after the 9.30am Mass, Tea & Coffee will be available in the Sacristy for all who are able to stay and join us.
