WEDNESDAY AUGUST 22 - Pilgrimage to the birthplace of St Thomas de Cantilupe at Hambleton

St Thomas, the 13th century
Bishop of Hereford, was born in



the village of Hambleden in the Thames Valley and is thus a link between our own Diocese and the Anglican Diocese of Hereford.

Hereford Cathedral are organising a pilgrimage for 22 August and have invited a little group of parishioners from here to join them in the ancient church where St Thomas was baptised. Arriving at 10.00am for coffee and a chat followed at 11.00am there will be a service in the church. It is expected that the service will be an Anglican Eucharist (which naturally we do not share) but the focus of the service is to be a renewal of Baptismal promises at the font where St Thomas was baptised. We shall travel to Hambleden in cars (for which drivers may claim travel expenses if they are carrying others) If you are joining us please put your name on the list, at the back of the church, and if you are a driver please indicate how many you can carry).
