40 HOURS DEVOTION To mark the Eucharistic Congress to be held in Liverpool we shall be having a 40 hours of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, beginning at 6.00am on Friday 7 September and continuing through to 10.00pm

the following day. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Prayer in the presence of Jesus is one of the great devotions of the Church and a means for each one of us, young or old, to grow in faith and in holiness. This 40 hours is to be offered as an Act of Reparation for the sins and crimes committed by those in the Church as we express our collective sorrow at those sins and ask our Lord in confident hope to show His Church the way forward. The Saturday Mass on 8 September will be a Mass of Reparation where I shall be speaking about how we might respond to those who rightly criticise the Church for the crimes of its members, and seeking to address questions about how it could have happened and where we go from here. Hopefully, all parishioners will take part in this 40 hours – even if you might only be able to drop in for 5 minutes or so. Prayer leaflets will be made available for those who may be unused to praying in this way, and Confessions will be available throughout the period. Let us make this a real action of our Parish by our participation. For those who can commit themselves to certain times of being present there is a list at the back of the Church for people to sign up for half hour slots. PLEASE NOTE a 24 hour clock is used to avoid confusion between ‘am’ and ‘pm’!
