DEDICATION OF THE CHURCH 19 OCTOBER 7.PM

The Formal Dedication of a Church is a moment of great importance for the Parish Community. It is a solemn statement that this building is a place set aside for God, for the celebration of the Sacraments and as a House of Prayer. It is a statement that here God lives among us in His house. Many people wonder why this has not already been done. When the Church was new it still had a debt to be paid off, and through the 70s and 80s it was a ceremony that was rarely, if ever, carried out. It is a good time for us to be doing this, as we begin a new phase of the renewal of the Church and of the Faith at St Augustine's, following last year's Mission.
