THE CHURCH IS PRESENTLY CLOSED.

CHURCH OPENING: As of tomorrow, **Monday 15 June**, we are once more allowed to have our churches open for private prayer. There are various safety procedures we have to follow and we need to have two stewards on duty all the time the church is open, to ensure that these are followed. If you are coming to the church to pray, please enter through the porch and read the Instructions there. The exit will be through the small door beside the Sacristy. If someone is coming who cannot manage the steps and needs to use the side door they should ring the Presbytery first so that we can make arrangements for them. To mark the opening, the church will be open on **Monday from 5.00 to 7.00pm**. After that the opening times will be on **Saturdays and Sundays (beginning on the weekend of June 20/21) from 2.00 to 5.00pm**. These times may be extended if we get more volunteers to act as stewards. Stewards should not be over 70 years of age, and should be free of any health conditions which may put them at risk from the COVID-19 virus. A big thank you to all those who have already volunteered their services in this role.

SUNDAY MORNING TEA & COFFEE ON

ZOOM: Following the Sunday morning Mass Deacon Brin began last week a meeting for a coffee and a chat. Since there was a good response to this it has been decided to continue with it as one means of parishioners keeping in touch with one another. If you want to join you do need to have installed the 'Zoom' app on your phone or computer. After Mass go and get yourself a drink and then come back shortly after 12.00 and open up Zoom. To find our meeting **today** you will need to activate Zoom and enter a meeting ID and password (this will be posted on the parish website (<https://st-augustines-church.org.uk>) from 8.30 on the Sunday morning, then removed after the meeting. You may have to wait a few moments for Brin to see you are seeking to enter, but he will 'open the door' for you. You may choose just to stay briefly and say hello. You may come on some Sundays and not on others. You may stay until everyone else goes away! It doesn't matter. There is no agenda, no 'input' - just time for a chat and a cuppa.
