BECOMING DISCIPLES -111: We continue to think about ways in which people can be more actively involved in the life of the Parish Community. **While some work is only able to be done by adults, children who have made their First Holy Communion** are also able to share in some ministries which are open to all ages. Some might wish to become **ALTAR SERVERS**, a ministry which helps to grow an understanding of the Liturgy.
