



WEEKDAY PARKING NEAR ST AUGUSTINE'S CHURCH

Because our church is so near to a main commuter station into London, weekday parking in its vicinity is very difficult and spaces in most of the locations on this map cannot be guaranteed. The Church's own car park is very small, and room there needs to be kept free for clergy, the undertakers' cars, and the disabled.

If coming from outside the town, we *strongly recommend* the Park and Ride service from the Leisure Centre near Junction 4 of the M40, where you can park for £1.20 for four hours and get an every-15-minute bus (£2.70 return) to the Station ; from there, the Church is a five-minute walk uphill.

But if you do not have time for that, or need to drop off a limited-mobility passenger, be sure to allow yourself time to try several of these locations as marked above

1. On-street metered parking within a few minutes walk (Priory Road, Greenway, Rectory Avenue, Peterborough Avenue, Duke Street). These are all pay-and-display areas , so be sure you have some coins, a debit card or the Ring-Go app on your phone. Maximum stay four hours which should be enough for a funeral and burial. Coins needed. **All likely to be mostly full with residents.**
2. Priory Avenue - probably the nearest Pay-and-display, but watch out for a short maximum stay. In August 22 the payment machines were both out of order
3. Totteridge Road pay car park. A small triangle near the Wilkinson Sword six-storey office. Number-plate recognition, pay on exit. But unlikely to have spaces. Cards and coins
4. Duke Street pay car park. £2.00 up to 2 hours, £4.00 up to six hours. Number-plate recognition, pay on exit. But as it's near the Station east exit and is cheaper than the Station car park, unlikely to have any room. Cards and coins.
5. Easton Street multi-storey. Probably the best bet for a space, though may you have to drive up to the top. About 8-10 minutes walk (bit of a climb) from the Church. Number-plate recognition, pay before exit. Cards and coins. Up to 2 hrs £2.50, up to 4 hrs £3.00.
6. Station car park. Full of commuters by 09:30 and unlikely to have any room. £9.50 all day if you can find a space.

All charges believed correct as at August 2022
