ministry, here at **St. Augustine's, on Saturday 12 November, at 7pm**. A date for your diary. Everyone is welcome. Please invite your friends and family.

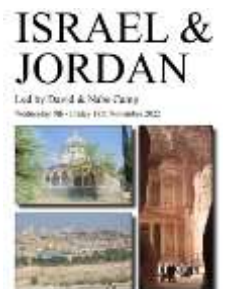
