stage of our journey towards a Synodal
Church. As was the case with our local
gracious listening and gracious speaking, this
Assembly is not to be necessarily making great
changes in the Church according to our own

ideas but is about the Church of Northampton
(including ourselves) coming together to
discern the will of the Holy Spirit. In these
weeks between Pentecost and the Assembly
let us all pray daily for the Holy Spirit to guide
the hearts and minds of all those taking part.
We are all called to our part in this work, for (as
we read in Ephesians 2:10) 'we are His
workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good
works, which God prepared beforehand so that
we could walk in them'
